Counselor Guidelines

1. Attend the “Counselor and Leaders” meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, June 20 on campus in the Main Auditorium for a brief training session.
2. Be ready to minister if needed at the close of each worship service and as needed throughout the week.
3. Counselors need to be at least 18 years old, full of integrity, with a teachable spirit. We desire individual counselors seasoned enough to put into proper perspective the unpredictable stresses that can occur during a week of ministry.
4. Your responsibilities for the week will include:
 - A. Relating to and looking out for your assigned youth from departure to return.
 - B. Have your assigned youth to all functions (morning sessions, meals and worship services) ON TIME!
 - C. Encourage students to have their quiet times each morning. You may choose to do it together as a group.
 - D. Be an example for your assigned youth at all functions.
 - E. See that your rooms are clean and orderly before breakfast. We cannot leave the rooms in a mess. There are no housekeepers to pick up after the students.
5. Should you at any time feel inadequate to handle a situation, seek out your youth pastor or one of the New Breed Network staff.
6. If you should disagree with any happenings or decision made by your youth pastor or the New Breed Network Leadership, seek to deal with it in a Biblical fashion.

Note: Complaining about it to your assigned youth could breed dissension and disharmony among the ranks. REMEMBER, God wants to use you as a point of contact for the week, so that the youth assigned to you are touched by God in a tangible way. You are important to the success of the week and the Kingdom of God.
7. Pack your own towel and bedding for a twin bed. Sleeping bags work great.

Note to the Youth Pastor: See that your counselors get a copy of this and the Ministry Guidelines before the conference.

Guidelines For Altar Ministry

1. With a servant spirit and attitude, approach the individual with loving words to inquire the reason for coming forward.
2. When ministering alone, minister only to people of the same sex. In today's world, no condition of ministry is absolutely safe. If there is any doubt, ministry should take place in teams.
3. When ministering to someone, a gentle touch on the forehead, top of head, shoulder or hands is usually the best method. Do not push, rub or massage, being careful to avoid inappropriate touching particularly when ministering to the opposite sex.
4. Assure the individual receiving ministry that he/she is the most important one for that moment. Avoid any remarks that would make a person feel they are unable to receive, that they do not have enough faith, that they are resisting the Spirit or any negative remarks that could lead to a feeling of rejection. Avoid letting your eyes wander to other things, people, or situations in the room.
5. Let the Lord deal with your heart so that sin does not shock you. Reacting inappropriately to their situation could cause them to pull back and not open up with you.
6. Your personal hygiene is essential. Please use breath mints. It is very distracting when the person praying for you has bad breath.
7. When using words of knowledge, prophecy or tongues, use discretion. Pray Biblical prayers related to those words. All interpretation given should be for the purpose of encouragement, edification, exhortation, or comfort. Please do not to give direction, correction, "dates" or "mates" as types of prophetic words. We recommend that any "word" be given in the presence of the youth pastor.
8. We will have designated ministry times; please do not take students out of the main session for ministry. Many times students need to hear what is being said in the service and the enemy likes to distract them as well as you from receiving.
9. If you need assistance while ministering, call for a youth pastor or one of the New Breed Ministry staff.

Security & Boundary Issues

We ask that you adhere to the following guidelines for a successful conference.

1. There will be no leaving the conference property without an approved counselor. No visitors will be allowed to attend any of the scheduled meetings without prior approval of your youth pastor.
 2. You are required to attend all scheduled sessions. Be on time! Do not go back to your room after a session has started, or between morning sessions. Do not leave the service before you are officially dismissed.
 3. Armbands must be worn **on the wrist** at all times for security reasons and as your meal pass.
 4. Please do not go past the boundaries established. You will have plenty of space to have a blast.
 5. The curfew (Lights out) will be announced each night by the New Breed Staff. The curfews must be observed for your protection. They are non-negotiable.
 6. We adhere to a “No Smoking” policy. Should you have an addiction to nicotine, you may use Nicotine gum or a patch for the week. Since it is against the law for minors to purchase tobacco, we do not choose to condone breaking the law. (This includes all smokeless tobacco.)
 7. For privacy and “total above reproach living”, there will be absolutely no guys in the girl’s rooms and no girls in the guy’s rooms. Not as much as near the door. Should you need to contact someone from the opposite sex, you reach can them through a friend or counselor. This will be enforced. (As a rule, if you can see into the room, you are too close.)
 8. Modesty is a major issue during the conference. Therefore, we ask that you adhere to the very livable modesty policy. Shorts may be worn, although you may prefer to wear jeans at night due to the temperature of the auditorium. Please keep all shorts at a modest length. If you need to ask if something is OK to wear, don’t wear it! **Swimsuits:** Guys: No sagging that shows your underwear or rear end. Ladies: If you wear a two-piece swimsuit, please wear a dark colored t-shirt at all times. Please be prepared to wear a cover-up or t-shirt to and from the water slide. Do not wear clothes that show your stomach. Our youth conference is not the place to get or show off your tan. Should your counselor feel that your swimsuit is not acceptable, don’t “freak-out!” Just wear a t-shirt over it. Hey gang; let’s help each other keep our hearts and minds on the Creator and not his creation.
- Note:** You may want to bring a sweatshirt or light jacket to the evening service.
9. To avoid distractions with going in and out during the service, use the restroom before the service. If you can sit through a 3-hour movie, you can make it through the service without leaving.
 10. Remember, irresponsibility can be costly. You will be charged for anything damaged in the rooms. Do not throw or drop anything from the balconies. Also, do not hang clothes or towels on the rails of the balconies. Any weapons or potentially dangerous items will be taken up by your counselor and not returned until you get home. (Don’t bring them!)

Note: All disciplinary issues will be handled by your individual youth pastor. NBN Security will only assist when asked. This is a week to learn more about walking in the Spirit of God. Those who continue pushing limits run the risk of being sent home. Attitude is very important. Should there be cases of continual problems, parents will be called and actions will be taken that are necessary to remedy the problem. Be assured that all such issues will be handled with grace and truth.

Student Guidelines

Summer conferences such as this have been used by God to radically change lives. We want to see you receive from the Lord Himself. In doing so, please help us eliminate as many of the outside hindrances that you are faced with on an ongoing basis. It is our desire to provide 4 days of atmosphere saturated with the presence of God. In order for our conference to be successful, we have established the following guidelines. Please agree to the following before leaving home.

1. Be prompt to all scheduled meetings. Adhere to all curfews.
2. Come with a desire to hear from God and have Him reveal Himself to you.
3. Abstain from bringing all electronic devices, and any questionable literature. Cell phones are fine as long as they are on silent during service times.
4. No water guns, water balloons, shaving cream fights or "rough-housing" allowed. Disruptive, destructive or dangerous behavior is prohibited. You will be responsible for replacement of anything you destroy.
5. There will be no leaving the property or inviting guests without the approval of your youth pastor.
6. Armbands must be worn at all times for identification and security as well as your meal ticket.
7. This is a university campus. There are no housekeepers. Therefore, clean your rooms before leaving each morning. Make your bed, keep your clothes in or "near" your suitcase, keep all trash picked up and the bathrooms free from clutter and floors dry.

What To Bring

1. Bible and pen
2. Casual clothes enough for 5 days, modest shorts are fine. Do not wear clothes that show your stomach. You will be asked to change. Please dress modestly. Cover-ups (t-shirts are fine) should be worn between the room and the water slide. **Swimsuits:** Guys: No sagging that shows your underwear or rear end. Ladies: If you wear a two piece swim suit, please wear a dark colored t-shirt at all times. Our youth conference is not the place to get or show off your tan. Should your counselor feel that your swimsuit is not acceptable, don't "freak-out!" Just wear a t-shirt over it. Hey gang; let's help each other keep our hearts and minds on the Creator and not His creation.
3. You may want to wear jeans at night due to the temperature of the auditorium. Bring a light jacket if needed.
4. Personal toiletries. (Plan ahead)
5. Bring your own linens: Towels and bedding for a twin bed. Sleeping bags are a great choice.

6. Spending money: \$50-\$75 is an average amount. (For snacks, t-shirt sales, CD's etc.)
